Procedure for submitting and defending the Ph.D. thesis

- Readiness for the defense and interest in the date will be expressed by the supervisor via the form at: https://forms.office.com/r/mWXVz7awyB. The Ph.D. Study Board's Secretariat will consult with the supervisor and the student about the final date in the near future.
- When selecting the opponents, the criteria of Art.11 of the Code of study and examination of Charles University must be observed: <u>https://cuni.cz/UKEN-726.html</u>
- If the supervisor wants to suggest opponents, it is advisable to find out their preliminary willingness and time availability. The appointment of opponents is subject to the prior approval of the State Final Examinations and Defenses Committee, and therefore the supervisor sends them to the Chair of the Committee
 (zbynek.tonar@lfp.cuni.cz) together with evidence of fulfilment of the criteria for the defense, including publications, which are a condition for the authorisation of the defense.
- If the Ph.D. thesis submitted for defense includes papers with multiple co-authors, the candidate is supposed to specify his/her own specific contribution to these publications in the preface or appendices. The rules for authorship defined by editorial offices of some publishing houses may be a guide, e.g. https://www.elsevier.com/authors/policies-and-guidelines/credit-author-statement, or consensus documents defining the roles of authors in the biomedical field https://www.icmje.org/recommendations/browse/roles-and-responsibilities/defining-the-role-of-authors-and-contributors.html.
